Household Hazardous Waste and Electronics

Yard Waste & Residential Demo

Hastings residents can dispose of their yard waste at the curbside, by making prior arrangements with Tennis Sanitation, or by taking it to the Tennis Yard Waste Site.

Free Grass and Leaf Drop-Off

Material must be in either a compostable paper bag or the container must be emptied and removed from the site. No loose materials accepted.

Free Brush Disposal

Must be bundled, no longer than 4 feet in length, 3 inches in diameter, and no more than 40 pounds.

Residential Demolition Material

\$20/cubic yard (\$20 minimum charge)

Weekly Disposal

Please remember that many items can be disposed of on a weekly basis as part of your regular pick-up and recycling.

Mixed Paper - junk mail, phone books, magazines, cardboard, newspaper, egg cartons, food boxes, glass jars & bottles, metal cans, milk cartons, juice boxes, aerosol cans, plastic bottles, containers and jugs, household scrap metal and more! What Can You Bring?

Hastings Residents:

(Fees apply - checks/cash/credit cards accepted)

These bulky items will be unloaded first - please pack your vehicle accordingly!

Appliances (\$15)

- Washers/dryers
- stoves
- air conditioners
- fridges/freezers
- water heater
- microwaves

Carpet/Furniture (\$5 - \$10)

- chairs
- couches
- tables
- mattresses

Scrap Iron (\$2-\$10)

- grills
- lawn mowers
- leaf/snow blowers
- bicycles

Const. Debris (\$3)

- concrete
- door/window
- wood/timbers
- sink/toilet/tub

or by the truckload:

1/4 load = \$15
1/2 load = \$5
Full load = \$10

or by the truckload:

Dakota County Residents: Free

Household Hazardous Waste

Aerosols, antifreeze, batteries (all types), fluorescent light bulbs, lawn & garden chemicals, mercury thermometers, paint - latex or oil, propane tanks/gas cylinders, thermometers/thermostats, and most products labeled dangerous, flammable, combustible, poisonous, or corrosive.

Electronics - Free

except TVs & Computer Monitors

Cell phones, laptops, stereos, portable media players, VCR/DVD players, vacuums (no bags), coffee makers (remove glass), blenders (remove glass).

TVs & Monitors: \$10 each Checks to 'HHW' or cash

Shredding

Bring your confidential documents to be properly destroyed by a mobile shredding company.
