



2019 Neighborhood Infrastructure Improvements Construction Update #13 – 8/30/2019

What has happened during the past week?

Area 1:

- Work on catch basin replacements and spot curb replacements has begun on Louis Lane
- Concrete driveways and driveway aprons have been completed on 21st St
- Grading and placement of the base layer of gravel has been completed on Manor Ln and Manor Ct

Area 2:

- Sidewalk installation has been completed along 31st St
- Manhole and gate valve castings have been raised to finished grade in advance of paving the final layer of asphalt

What is scheduled for the week of September 2nd?

Area 1:

- Grading and placement of the gravel base material will begin on 19th St – **Areas where curb, driveways and aprons have already been completed are now accessible by vehicle, please do not park on 19th St between Manor Ln and Louis Ln so street grading can begin unimpeded**
- Installation of new concrete curb and gutter is scheduled for Manor Ln and Manor Ct north of 19th St for mid to late next week. Affected residents will receive additional information via door-to-door fliers.
- Spot curb removals will begin on Louis Ln and 18th and 19th St between Manor Ln and Pine St
- Final grading on streets with curb and gutter completed will begin
- Grading work in the swale area between Louis Ln and Ridge Ln will begin

Area 2:

- Paving of the final layer of asphalt will begin as early as Tuesday, September 3rd
- Placement of top soil and seeding will begin in all disturbed areas adjacent to new concrete
