Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received with ONLINE PROJECT BIDDING ONLY, through QuestCDN.com until **10:00am CST, on Thursday, March 19, 2026**, for the 2026 Mill & Overlay Program. No bids will be accepted after this deadline. The bids will be opened on QuestCDN using Microsoft Teams, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud by City representatives. Bids are for furnishing all work and materials for milling (2") and overlaying 3.3 miles of residential streets with spot concrete curb replacement, spot replacement of rings and castings on manholes and catch basins, gate valve re-bolting, providing truncated domes on sidewalk pedestrian ramps, and additional sidewalk replacement. All work shall be completed in accordance with the plans and specifications on file. Major construction quantities include:

- **64,000 SY of Mill Bit Pavement (2")**
- **7,330 Ton of Bit Street Paving**
- **4,700 LF of B618 Concrete Curb & Gutter**
- **30 Pedestrian Ramps (Truncated Domes)**
- **18 Adjust Rings & Castings**
- **5 Rebolt Gate Valve**

For an online bidding fee of \$42.00, all bids must be submitted ONLINE THROUGH QuestCDN.com and include the proposal forms furnished with the plans and specifications including completed forms certifying that the bidder is a responsible contractor per MN Statute 16C.285. No bid will be considered unless filed ONLINE with the bid bond, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid as a guarantee that the bidder will enter in to a contract to perform said work. These bid bonds of the three lowest bidders will be retained until a contract has been awarded and signed by all concerned, but no longer than 60 days. All others will be returned within 7 days after the opening of bids.

The bids for the work to be done shall be submitted upon the basis of cash payment for the work. No bidder may withdraw this bid for a period of 60 days after the date shown for opening thereof. The City of Hastings reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, waive informalities therein.

The City Council will consider award of contracts at their regular meeting to be held on Monday, April 6, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at 101 4th Street East, Hastings, Minnesota or online via Zoom.
