



Central Water Treatment Plant Raw Watermain Project Construction Update #5 – 10/24/2025

What has happened during the past week?

- Watermain installation is finished between the well house on 9th Street and Lions Park. All utility replacements are complete, and road replacement work has started.

What is scheduled for the week of October 27th?

- Construction crews will proceed with rebuilding the roadway by installing aggregate surfacing and replacing the concrete curb and gutter. Concrete curb replacement is scheduled for Thursday, contingent upon weather conditions. ***Please note that driveway access may be temporarily restricted while the new concrete curb undergoes curing.***
- Directional drilling of the new watermain along North Frontage Road, extending from the water treatment plant to Westview Drive, will commence. North Frontage Road will remain accessible to through traffic during this period; however, it may be temporarily reduced to a single lane to accommodate equipment movement.

Important Notes

- Please refrain from parking on streets under construction from 7 AM to 7 PM.
- During construction hours (7 AM to 7 PM), access will be maintained but may be delayed.
