



2026 Neighborhood Infrastructure Improvements Construction Update #10 – 7/31/2026

What has happened during the past week?

- Concrete curb and driveway construction was completed on Pleasant Drive.
- Grading of road base in preparation for asphalt began on Pleasant Drive.
- Impacted homes were connected to the temporary water system on 4th Street.
- Watermain improvements began along 4th Street.

What is scheduled for the week of August 3rd?

- Watermain improvements will continue and sanitary sewer improvements will begin along 4th Street.
- Boulevard restoration and preparation for the new trail along Pleasant Drive will begin.
- Paving on Pleasant drive is tentatively scheduled Tuesday, August 4th. **Impacted residents will receive additional info via door hanger.**

Paving Notes:

- No Parking allowed Tuesday, August 4th, from 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM on Pleasant Drive
- All driveways will be open by the end of the day on Monday (the day before paving). During the paving operations you may park in your driveway. You may continue to use the temporary driveways if your main driveway is not open. If your driveway has a “gap” in between the concrete and asphalt, this will be temporarily filled with gravel to ensure access. The paving of this area will happen at a later date.
- This will be the “base course” of pavement; the final “wear course” layer will be placed at a later date to match the existing curb height.

Important Notes

- **The intersection of Pleasant Drive and 4th Street will remain closed until Paving is completed. Paving will tentatively be completed at the end of the day on Tuesday. Once paving is completed, the intersection will be open for local traffic. See detour on page 2** (reverse side) of this update.
- Please do not touch the installed wooden stakes, as they are critical for construction.
- Please refrain from parking on streets under construction from 7 AM to 7 PM
