Dear Property Owner/Resident:

This second notification letter serves as a courtesy to inform you the 15th & Bailly Stormwater Basin Project will begin the **week of May 11th**. In preparation, you will likely see:

- Installation of "Trail Closed" signs.
- Installation of trail protection.
- Utility locates marked with paint and flags.
- Surveyors staking infiltration basin and tree removal area.

During the first week of the project, crews may:

- Remove and chip trees within the proposed basin area.

The following week, crews may:

- Begin excavation of proposed basin.
- Haul excess material via 15th/Bailly trail corridor.

Tree removal and hauling out of the excess material will be the most disruptive part of the project. You may see a few trucks on 15th St waiting to be backed up on the trail. This process will take approximately 3-4 days. Contractor has been instructed to adhere to the "no parking" restrictions along 15th St and Bailly St.

Please be mindful of the construction workers and exercise caution by staying clear of the project, finding alternate routes if possible. The City acknowledges the disruption and inconveniences it brings to the neighborhood but thanks you in advance for your cooperation during the project! The project will take approximately four weeks to complete.
