



Q1 What is your age?




Q2 What is your gender?




Q8 Do you rent or own your current home?






Q9 What size is your current home?




Q10 If you were to move in the next 5 years (within or outside Hastings), what type of housing would you be likely to seek?






Q11 How much of your gross monthly household income do you spend on housing (mortgage or rent)? You may skip any questions you prefer not to answer.




Q18 In your opinion, how would you describe the availability of employment opportunities within Hastings?





Q19 How often do you patronize a Hastings business for the following services?




Q34 Indicate your level of agreement: The City of Hastings should expand its use of alternative and renewable energy.
